This matter is before the Commission on respondent's response to Order No. 12,761, served March 14, 2011.

Order No. 12,761 assessed a civil forfeiture against respondent, suspended Certificate No. 1312 for 90 days from April 13, 2011, through July 11, 2011, and placed respondent on probation for two years commencing March 14, 2011, for respondent's knowing and willful violation of Article XI, Section 6(a), of the Compact and Commission Regulation No. 58. The order further directed respondent to file a statement under oath after the suspension period had run verifying compliance.

Respondent paid the forfeiture on March 28, 2011, and filed a statement under oath on July 28 verifying that respondent did not transport passengers between points in the Metropolitan District during the suspension period.

Accordingly, this investigation is hereby terminated. As provided in Order No. 12,761, respondent shall remain on probation until 12:00 a.m. March 14, 2013, and a willful violation of the Compact, or of the Commission's rules, regulations or orders thereunder, by respondent during the probation period shall constitute grounds for immediate suspension and/or revocation of respondent's operating authority regardless of the nature and severity of the violation.
