This matter is before the Commission on the cancellation of respondent's WMATC Insurance Endorsement effective at 12:01 a.m. on August 24, 2011, pursuant to written notice filed with the Commission on July 19, 2011.

This proceeding was initiated on May 1, 2011, when the \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated without replacement and Certificate No. 320 became automatically suspended as a result under Regulation No. 58-12. The suspension was lifted in Order No. 12,853 on May 10, 2011, after respondent filed an acceptable \$5 million replacement Endorsement on May 5, 2011. The investigation was continued in accordance with Regulation No. 58-14, however, because the effective date of the May 5 endorsement was May 3, 2011, instead of May 1, 2011. Respondent later filed a second endorsement on May 12, 2011, with an effective date of May 2, 2011.

The May 12 Endorsement was subsequently cancelled by respondent's insurance company on July 19, 2011, effective August 24, 2011, and has not been replaced.

According to Regulation No. 58-12: "Failure to replace a WMATC Insurance Endorsement prior to termination shall result in immediate, automatic suspension of a carrier's WMATC operating authority. The carrier must suspend operations immediately and may not recommence operations unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission."¹

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 320 unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.
