By letter dated August 9, 2011, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish evidence of its U.S. DOT registration and a current list of applicant's officers, directors, and members within 14 days. Applicant has yet to respond.

In addition, the check tendered by applicant in payment of the \$250 application fee was returned unpaid by applicant's bank.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Starfleet Transportation, LLC, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
