By letter dated August 10, 2011, applicant was notified of acceptance of his application for a certificate of authority and directed to file a statement specifying the complete address of applicant's principal place of business, applicant's complete mailing address, and a description of proposed service and proposed rates. Applicant has yet to respond.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Michael Seifu, trading as Limo Treat, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
