Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1714 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on October 20, 2011, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1714 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$50 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 13,026, served October 20, 2011.

Respondent filed a \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on October 26, 2011, with an effective date of October 20, 2011, and an expiration date of October 29, 2011. Then on October 27, 2011, respondent filed acceptable \$1.5 million primary and \$3.5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements, each with an effective date of October 29, 2011, and an expiration date of October 29, 2012. Respondent thereafter paid the \$50 late fee on November 10, 2011.

Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
