By application filed February 1, 2012, L & J Limo Services LLC seeks voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1605.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder. The application shall be denied if applicant is not in good standing with the Commission.¹

Each carrier holding a certificate of authority on the first day of the calendar year must file an annual report and pay an annual fee on or before January 31 of that year.² Applicant held Certificate No. 1605 on January 1 of this year but has yet to pay its annual fee and did not file an acceptable annual report until after the January 31 deadline. Applicant also owes \$300 in late fees pursuant to Regulation No. 67-03. Consequently, applicant is not in good standing.

Until such time as applicant has complied with Regulation No. 67 by paying the annual fee for 2012, plus \$300 in late fees, the request for voluntary termination shall not be approved.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application of L & J Limo Services LLC for voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1605 is hereby denied without prejudice.
