Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 69 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$100 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$1 million primary and \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent expired on March 1, 2012, and have not been replaced. Certificate No. 69, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 and may be revoked if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late fee within thirty days.

In addition, respondent has not filed a 2012 annual report. Under Regulation No. 67-03, respondent also owes \$150 in late fees for failure to timely file a 2012 annual report.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 69, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within 30 days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s), submit a 2012 annual report, and pay the sum of \$250 by money order or check, or show cause why Certificate No. 69 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.
