Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 69 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on March 1, 2012, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 69 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 13,181, served March 1, 2012.¹ The order also directed respondent to file an overdue 2012 annual report and pay a \$150 late report fee.

Respondent subsequently submitted an acceptable \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement, filed an acceptable 2012 annual report, and paid the \$250 in late fees. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.

¹ The order also stated that respondent's \$1 million primary WMATC Endorsement had likewise terminated without replacement. That statement was in error. The automatic suspension of Certificate No. 69 nevertheless took place on March 1, 2012, due to respondent's failure to replace the \$4 million excess Endorsement before its March 1 expiration date.
