Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1605 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum. Under Regulation No. 67-03(c), \$100 is due and payable upon the failure of a carrier to timely file an acceptable WMATC Insurance Endorsement.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent expired on March 9, 2012, and has not been replaced. Certificate No. 1605, therefore, is automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12 and may be revoked if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late fee within 30 days.

In addition, under Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, respondent owes a \$150 annual fee that was due January 31, 2012, a \$150 late fee for not paying the annual fee on time, and a \$150 late fee for filing its 2012 annual report one day late on February 1, 2012, for a total of \$450 in addition to the \$100 late insurance fee.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That respondent shall not transport passengers for hire under Certificate No. 1605, unless and until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

2. That within 30 days, respondent shall file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay the sum of \$550 by check or money order or show cause why Certificate No. 1605 should not be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.
