Certificate No. 1807 has been suspended since February 2, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,141, served February 3, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1807 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1807 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

In addition, respondent has yet to comply with the requirements in Regulation Nos. 60-01 and 67-02 that respondent tender on or before January 31, 2012, a 2012 annual report and \$150 annual fee. The annual report and fee shall remain due, along with \$300 in associated late fees mandated by Regulation No. 67-03(a),(b).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1807 is hereby revoked.
2. That respondent's 2012 annual report and \$550 in fees shall remain due under Regulation Nos. 60 and 67, respectively.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1807 to the Commission.
