Certificate No. 1605 has been suspended since March 9, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,190, served March 9, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1605 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late insurance fee within thirty days. In addition, the order noted that respondent had yet to pay the \$150 annual fee for 2012 and that respondent had been assessed \$300 in late fees for failing to tender its 2012 annual report and annual fee on time.

Respondent subsequently tendered a \$450 check on April 11, 2012, in payment of the \$150 annual fee and \$300 in associated late fees. Respondent, however, has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the \$100 late insurance fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1605 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1605 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61; and
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement.
