This matter is before the Commission on applicant's request for an extension of time to comply with Commission Order No. 13,007, served October 6, 2011. The order conditionally granted Certificate of Authority No. 1857 and stipulated that applicant would have the full 180 days available under Commission Regulation No. 66, or until April 3, 2012, to satisfy the conditions of the grant. On March 16, 2012, applicant requested an extension of the deadline.

Regulation No. 66-01 states: "Except as provided in Regulation No. 66-02, the time for complying with the conditions of a grant of authority shall not be extended beyond 180 days from the date of the grant. A conditional grant of authority shall be void on the 181st day following the date of the grant if full compliance has not been achieved at that time." Regulation No. 66-02 states: "Upon timely request for an extension of the 180-day deadline in Regulation No. 66-01, the Commission's Executive Director may grant a maximum extension of 31 days." The request having been timely filed, an extension of 31 days shall be granted.

Inasmuch as applicant substantially satisfied the conditions of the grant by the extended deadline of May 3, 2012, Certificate No. 1857 shall be issued.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Certificate of Authority No. 1857 shall be issued to Dominique Transportation Services, LLC, trading as Innovative Medical Transport & University Shuttle Services, 4953 6th Street, N.E., Washington, DC, 20017-2310.
