Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1497 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$2 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated at 12:01 a.m. on May 15, 2012, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 1497 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 13,266, served May 15, 2012.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement later that day, and respondent's insurance broker paid the \$100 late fee on respondent's behalf on May 25, 2012. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
