Certificate No. 1810 was automatically suspended on May 2, 2012, pursuant to Regulation No. 67-04 as a result of respondent's failure to pay \$300 in late fees under Regulation No. 67-03(a),(b) on or before May 1, 2012.

Order No. 13,252, served May 7, 2012, gave respondent 30 days to pay said fees or face revocation of Certificate No. 1810. Respondent has yet to comply.

Certificate No. 1810 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to comply with Commission Regulation No. 67 and Commission Order No. 13,252. The \$300 in unpaid fees shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1810 is hereby revoked.
2. That \$300 in fees shall remain due under Regulation No. 67.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1810 to the Commission.
