Certificate No. 259 was suspended on June 3, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,303, served June 4, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 259 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent filed the necessary insurance endorsement(s), but respondent has yet to pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 259 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 259 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 259 to the Commission.
