Certificate No. 1810 was revoked in Order No. 13,326, served June 22, 2012, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to pay \$300 in late fees under Regulation No. 67-03(a), (b) on or before June 6, 2012. Respondent subsequently paid the late fees and filed an application for reconsideration of Order No. 13,326.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent timely filed the application for reconsideration on July 20, 2012, but the application does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that respondent has paid the late fees, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative<sup>1</sup> and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 1810.<sup>2</sup>
