Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1776 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The Commission issued Order No. 13,382 on August 7, 2012, announcing the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 1776 under Regulation No. 58-12 when it appeared that the \$2.5 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent had terminated without replacement.

On August 10, 2012, the Commission discovered that an acceptable \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement with an effective date of August 7, 2012, had been filed on August 6, 2012.

Under the circumstances, it appears Order No. 13,382 was issued in error. Order No. 13,382 shall accordingly be rescinded and the suspension vacated.¹
