This matter is before the Commission on the response of Paramed Medical Transportation, Inc., (Paramed) to Order No. 13,345, served July 13, 2012.

The order directed Paramed to show cause within 30 days why Certificate No. 206 should not be suspended or revoked for Paramed's failure to timely pay a \$1,750 civil forfeiture assessed in Order No. 12,723, as modified by Order No. 13,115, approving an installment payment plan. Order No. 13,345 noted that Paramed had made one payment of \$500 on March 21, 2012, but had failed to make any of the other scheduled payments.

Paramed paid the remaining \$1,250 balance on July 20, 2012.

We find that Paramed's belated full payment of the forfeiture constitutes good cause for not suspending or revoking Certificate No. 206.

Accordingly, this proceeding is hereby terminated.
