By email dated August 17, 2012, applicant was directed to furnish certain financial information on or before August 31. According to the application, applicant is in the latter stages of a bankruptcy proceeding. Additional financial information was sought to ensure a full and fair determination of this application. The email cautioned applicant that failure to timely produce the additional information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

Applicant was directed to produce a number of documents, including a copy of the most recent bankruptcy court order and the past 13 months of bank statements for applicant and applicant's owner, Mr. Shafqat Satti. Applicant produced no bankruptcy court order and only two months of bank statements.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Four Points Transportation and Moving Inc. for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
