Case No. MP-2012-067

Certificate No. 1854 has been suspended since July 6, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,338, served July 6, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1854 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent failed to timely respond. Respondent later filed the necessary WMATC Endorsement, but respondent has yet to pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1854 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1854 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee under WMATC Regulation No. 67-03(c) shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 1854 to the Commission.
