By letter dated August 13, 2012, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information, including a current certificate of good standing, no later than August 27, 2012. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. On September 26, 2012, applicant furnished some of the requested information, along with a statement that "it will be forwarded a good standing cert. as soon as I receive it." (sic). On November 1, 2012, applicant furnished an additional statement regarding other passenger carrier authority. Applicant has yet to produce a current certificate of good standing.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Nat Sedan Services LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
