By letter dated August 30, 2012, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than September 13, 2012. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has produced some of the requested information, but has yet to file evidence of its passenger carrier authority from the Maryland Public Service Commission.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Amasia Travel International Inc for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
