Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 324 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1 million primary and \$500,000 excess WMATC Insurance Endorsements on file for respondent terminated on September 26, 2012, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 324 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 13,497, served September 26, 2012.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1 million primary WMATC Endorsement on November 6, 2012 and an acceptable \$500,000 excess WMATC Endorsement on November 7, 2012, and respondent's insurance broker tendered a \$100 check on respondent's behalf on November 8, 2012. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
