Certificate No. 1859 was automatically suspended on October 12, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,523, served October 12, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1859 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. On November 13, 2012, respondent paid the \$100 late fee by money order and filed an application requesting voluntary termination of Certificate No. 1859. The application was accompanied by the original Certificate No. 1859, issued October 21, 2011.

The Commission may terminate a certificate of authority under Title II of the Compact, Article XI, Section 10(b), upon application by the holder.

The application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1859 is hereby terminated, effective this date.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:
 - a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61; and
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement.
