Certificate No. 1526 was automatically suspended September 23, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,492, served September 24, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1526 would be "subject to revocation pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact, if respondent fails to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and pay \$100 by money order, check, or online by credit card, within thirty days." (Emphasis added).

The record shows that the U.S. Postal Service delivered Order No. 13,492 to respondent more than 50 days ago on October 2, 2012. The record also shows that although respondent has filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement, respondent has yet to pay the late fee, notwithstanding an email sent by Commission staff to respondent on November 5, 2012, advising respondent to pay the late fee "right away" because respondent's authority "has been suspended for more than 30 days and is up for revocation."

Accordingly, Certificate No. 1526 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.¹

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1526 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and

c. surrender Certificate No. 1526 to the Commission.
