Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 135 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on December 1, 2012, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 135 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 13,618, served December 3, 2012.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$4 million excess WMATC Insurance Endorsement on December 5, 2012, and respondent's insurance broker tendered a \$100 check on behalf of respondent on December 6, 2012. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
