Certificate No. 1748 has been suspended since October 18, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,535, served October 18, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1748 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within thirty days. Respondent paid the late fee but has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s). Accordingly, Certificate No. 1748 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1748 is hereby revoked.
2. That within 30 days from the date of this order, Butler Medical Transport, LLC, trading as Butler Mobility, 10233 S. Dolfield Road, Owings Mills, MD, 21117-3620, shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 1748 to the Commission.
