Certificate No. 1749 was automatically suspended October 14, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,524, served October 15, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1749 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) *"and pay \$100 by money order, check, or online by credit card, within thirty days."* (Emphasis added). The record shows that the U.S. Postal Service delivered Order No. 13,524, to respondent on October 18, 2012. The record also shows that respondent filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) but has yet to pay the late fee, notwithstanding an email from the Commission reminding respondent on October 16, 2012, that the late fee had not been paid and attaching a copy of Order No. 13,524. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1749 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1749 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.

3. That within 30 days from the date of this order DC Nation, Incorporated, 5909 Coverdale Way, #J, Alexandria, VA, 22310-5405, shall:

- a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 1749 to the Commission.
