By letter dated December 3, 2012, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than December 17, 2012. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. The letter was returned by the U.S. Postal Service on December 12, 2012, marked "not deliverable as addressed."

On December 17, 2012, applicant requested an extension of time to comply with the Commission's application requirements.

On December 20, 2012, the Commission sent a letter to applicant extending the deadline and directing applicant to furnish the additional information no later than January 3, 2012. In addition to the information previously requested, applicant was also directed to file a statement explaining why mail to applicant was returned to sender. A copy of the letter was also sent to applicant via e-mail that same day.

Applicant filed a response on January 3, 2013, but the response did not include a statement explaining why mail sent to the address listed in the application was returned to sender.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³
