By letter dated December 13, 2012, applicant was notified of acceptance of his application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than December 27, 2012. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

Applicant previously controlled God's Will Transportation Inc., (God's Will), which held WMATC Certificate No. 1139 from April 11, 2007, until March 25, 2008, when it was revoked in WMATC Order No. 11,230. The Commission's December 13 letter sought among other things a statement indicating when God's Will ceased WMATC operations and whether those operations had recommenced. Applicant responded to the letter on December 17, 2012, but the response did not include said statement.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Anthony Ambrose Achoronye, trading as PVFP Medical Group, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
