Certificate No. 1748 was revoked in Order No. 13,639, served December 26, 2012, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58. Respondent subsequently filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) and an application for reconsideration of Order No. 13,639.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. The instant application was timely filed, but it does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that within the 30-day period for seeking reconsideration, respondent filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) with no interruption in coverage, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate No. 1748, provided that to prevent circumvention of Regulation Nos. 60-01 and 67-02, respondent shall file a 2013 annual report and pay the 2013 annual fee within 30 days of the date of this order.¹
