Certificate No. 99 was revoked in Order No. 13,643, served December 26, 2012, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to pay the \$100 late fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c). Respondent subsequently paid the late fee and filed an application for reconsideration of Order No. 13,643 on January 11, 2013.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within thirty days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. The instant application was timely filed, but it does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that respondent paid the late fee within the 30-day period for seeking reconsideration, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 99, provided that to prevent circumvention of Regulation Nos. 60-01 and 67-02, respondent shall file a 2013 annual report and pay the 2013 annual fee within 30 days of the date of this order.¹
