Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 1145 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The Commission issued Order No. 13,740 on February 13, 2013, announcing the automatic suspension of Certificate No. 1145 under Regulation No. 58-12 when it appeared that the \$1.5 million WMATC Insurance Endorsement filed on respondent's behalf by National Continental Insurance Company on February 14, 2012, had terminated on February 13, 2013, without replacement. On February 15, 2013, however, the Commission discovered that an acceptable \$1.5 million replacement Endorsement with an effective date of June 8, 2012, and an expiration date of June 8, 2013, had been filed on respondent's behalf by Selective Insurance Company of America on June 22, 2012.

Under the circumstances, it appears Order No. 13,740 was issued in error. Order No. 13,740 shall accordingly be rescinded and the suspension vacated.¹
