Certificate No. 554 has been suspended since December 28, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,649, served December 28, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 554 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 554 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

In addition, respondent has yet to file a 2013 annual report, which under Regulation No. 60-01 was due January 31, 2013. The annual report and associated \$150 late fee mandated by Regulation No. 67-03(a) shall remain due.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 554 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That the 2013 annual report and associated \$150 late fee shall remain due.
4. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 554 to the Commission.
