By email sent February 22, 2013, applicant was directed to address two issues in writing within 14 days.

One issue concerned applicant's street address and mailing address. The other issued concerned applicant's relationship with Ahmed Khan, the president of the company that paid the application fee in this proceeding. The email admonished that failure to timely address the issue(s) listed above would result in delay or dismissal of this application.

Applicant has addressed the address issue but not the relationship issue.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of USA Coach Inc., trading as American Bus Service, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
