Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 18 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on April 6, 2013, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 18 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 13,860, served April 8, 2013. The order also directed respondent to file an overdue 2013 annual report and pay a \$150 late report fee.

Respondent subsequently filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement, filed an acceptable 2013 annual report and paid the \$250 in late fees. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
