Certificate No. 1687 was suspended December 27, 2012, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,646, served December 27, 2012, noted that Certificate No. 1687 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent filed the necessary insurance endorsement(s) on February 4, 2013, but it was subsequently canceled on March 28, 2013, effective April 27, 2013, and has not been replaced. In addition, respondent has yet to pay the \$100 late insurance fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1687 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1687 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order respondent shall:
  - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
  - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
  - c. surrender Certificate No. 1687 to the Commission.
