By letter dated April 18, 2013, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish the following additional information no later than May 2, 2013.

- The application form indicates that applicant has been investigated by a transportation regulatory agency. File with the Commission a statement: (1) identifying the agency or agencies that investigated applicant and/or found applicant unfit; (2) describing the investigation(s) and/or finding(s); and (3) explaining applicant's current status.
- The wrong document was included with the application as applicant's mandatory Attachment A. File with the Commission a current certificate of good standing from the Maryland Department of Assessments and Taxation.
- The application fee was paid by check drawn on the account of Adrienne R. Layton. File with the Commission a statement describing applicant's relationship to Ms. Layton.
- File with the Commission a current list of applicant's 1) officers and 2) members (owners), along with a current mailing address and telephone number for each.

The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

Applicant filed a response on May 3. The response indicates that applicant once held a "DOT card" but does not indicate what is meant by that. The response includes a trade name registration certificate instead of a certificate of good standing. The response is silent with respect to the identities of any officers.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying

instructions.<sup>1</sup> An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.<sup>2</sup> Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.<sup>3</sup>

Inasmuch as applicant's response is late and fails to fully satisfy the additional information request, this application shall be dismissed.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Agape Medical Transportation LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
