By letter dated May 15, 2013, applicant was directed to furnish certain information no later than May 29, 2013. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

The letter directed applicant to file proof of registration of his proposed trade name with the Fairfax Circuit Court. The letter also directed applicant to file a copy of a current lease or utility bill evidencing his presence at the principal place of business and mailing addresses listed in the application. Applicant has yet to respond.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Ould Ahmed Ahmed, trading as J. A. Transportation, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
