Certificate No. 1820 was revoked in Order No. 13,810, served March 15, 2013, pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact for respondent's willful failure to maintain on file with the Commission proof of \$5 million in combined-single-limit, motor vehicle liability insurance as required by Commission Regulation No. 58 and willful failure to pay the \$100 late fee under Regulation No. 67-03(c). The order noted that the late fee would remain due. Respondent subsequently filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on March 22, 2013, paid the late fee on April 12, 2013, and submitted an application for reconsideration of Order No. 13,810.

Under Title II of the Compact, Article XIII, Section 4(a), an application for reconsideration of a Commission order must be filed within 30 days of its publication and state specifically the errors claimed as grounds for reconsideration. Respondent timely paid the late fee and filed the necessary endorsement as required by Regulation No. 58-15. The application for reconsideration, however, was filed late on April 16, 2013, and does not allege any error on the part of the Commission. The application therefore is denied.

However, considering that within the 30-day period for seeking reconsideration respondent paid the late fee and filed the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) with no interruption in coverage, we will reopen this proceeding on our own initiative and reinstate Certificate of Authority No. 1820.¹

IT IS SO ORDERED.
