Certificate No. 1811 was automatically suspended at 12:01 a.m. on April 8, 2013, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 13,861, served April 8, 2013, noted that Certificate No. 1811 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) "*and pay \$100 by money order, check, or online by credit card, within thirty days.*" (Emphasis added). Respondent subsequently submitted the necessary WMATC Insurance Endorsement(s) but has yet to pay the late fee, notwithstanding an email sent by the Commission to respondent on May 9, 2013, with a copy of Order No. 13,861 attached, as a reminder to pay the fee. Accordingly, Certificate No. 1811 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 1811 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order, RSTQ Transportation LLC, 13419 Duchin Road, Germantown, MD, 20874-1427, shall:
 - a. remove from respondent's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
 - b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
 - c. surrender Certificate No. 1811 to the Commission.
