By letter dated June 6, 2013, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later June 20, 2013, including "a copy of each motor carrier license, certificate or registration that applicant currently holds." The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has indicated that it holds passenger carrier authority from New Jersey and from Delaware, but applicant yet to submit a copy of the license, certificate, or registration issued by each state.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair examination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of Gem Ambulance, LLC, for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
