By letter dated June 17, 2013, applicant was granted an extension of the time to furnish certain information necessary for a full and fair determination of this application. Among the items of information requested was a list of applicant's members. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to furnish the information within 14 days would result in delay or dismissal of the application. Applicant has yet to furnish the list of applicant's members.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of KNK Charming Transport, L.L.C., for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
