By letter dated September 23, 2013, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than October 7, 2013, including "a copy of a lease or utility bill evidencing applicant's right to maintain an office at 11902 Winterthur Lane, #BH3, Reston, VA 20191-1932." The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

Applicant responded by timely submitting a single page of a multipage lease. Inasmuch as the signature page is missing, the lease excerpt submitted by applicant does not establish applicant's right to maintain an office at the location in question.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of A Safe Way Trans LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
