Certificate No. 2073 has been suspended since July 23, 2013, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 14,103, served July 23, 2013, noted that Certificate No. 2073 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days.

On August 23, 2013, respondent filed a request for an extension of time until September 26, 2013. Respondent, however, has yet to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay the late fee. Without some evidence that compliance is imminent, we find that respondent has not shown good cause for further extending the deadline.¹

Accordingly, Certificate No. 2073 shall be revoked pursuant to Article XI, Section 10(c), of the Compact.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 2073 is hereby revoked.
2. That the \$100 late insurance fee shall remain due.
3. That within 30 days from the date of this order, Senate Transportation Services Corp., 2637 4th Street, N.E., Washington, DC, 20002-1205, shall:
