Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 99 for a minimum of \$5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated on November 1, 2013, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 99 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 14,317, served November 4, 2013.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on November 6, 2013, and respondent's insurance company tendered a \$100 check on respondent's behalf on November 18, 2013. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
