Commission Regulation No. 58 requires respondent to insure the revenue vehicles operated under Certificate No. 2056 for a minimum of \$1.5 million in combined-single-limit liability coverage and maintain on file with the Commission at all times proof of coverage in the form of a WMATC Certificate of Insurance and Policy Endorsement (WMATC Insurance Endorsement) for each policy comprising the minimum.

The \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement on file for respondent terminated at 12:01 a.m. on October 11, 2013, without replacement. As a result, Certificate No. 2056 was automatically suspended under Regulation No. 58-12, and a \$100 late insurance fee became due and payable under Regulation No. 67-03(c), as noted in Order No. 14,273, served October 11, 2013.

Respondent filed an acceptable \$1.5 million primary WMATC Insurance Endorsement later that same day, and tendered a \$100 online credit card payment on November 22, 2013. Accordingly, the suspension is lifted, and this investigation is terminated.
