By letter dated November 26, 2013, applicant was notified of acceptance of its application for a certificate of authority and directed to furnish additional information no later than December 10, 2013, including the details of the regulatory agency investigation of applicant noted at page 3 of the application and a new, complete signature page (page 4), with an original signature.

Applicant timely responded with a complete signature page, but it lacks an original signature, and applicant has yet to provide a statement regarding the investigation noted on page 3 of the application.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of MNB Transportation LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
