By letter dated December 31, 2013, pursuant to Regulation No. 54-04(b), applicant was directed to furnish additional information regarding applicant's place of business. The Commission had mailed notice of acceptance of this application to the address listed in the application as applicant's principal place of business. The notice was returned by the U.S. Postal Service marked "Not Deliverable as Addressed". Applicant was then directed to file a copy of a complete lease or utility bill as evidence of applicant's right to occupy the premises at said address. The additional information was due no later than January 14, 2014. The letter cautioned applicant that failure to timely furnish the information would result in delay or dismissal of the application.

On January 10, 2014, applicant produced a partial lease for the address in question in the name of NSP Cleaning Services, LLC. Applicant is not named, and applicant has produced no utility bill.

Under the Compact, an application to obtain a certificate of authority shall be made in writing, verified, and shall contain the information required by the application form and accompanying instructions.¹ An applicant may be required to publish notice of the application in a newspaper of general circulation in the Metropolitan District and furnish any supplemental information necessary for a full and fair determination of the application.² Failure to comply with the Commission's application requirements warrants dismissal.³

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED: that the application of NSP Group LLC for a certificate of authority is hereby dismissed without prejudice for want of prosecution.
