Certificate No. 186 was automatically suspended on January 1, 2014, for respondent's willful failure to comply with the insurance requirements specified in Regulation No. 58. Order No. 14,452, served January 2, 2014, noted that Certificate No. 186 would be subject to revocation if respondent failed to file the necessary insurance endorsement(s) and pay a \$100 late fee within 30 days. Respondent paid the \$100 late fee on January 31, 2014, and filed a voluntary termination application on February 6, 2014.

The Executive Director may approve an application for voluntary termination under Regulation No. 54-08, provided the applicant is in good standing with the Commission.¹ Inasmuch as no fees or reports are currently due from Boston Coach and Boston Coach therefore is in good standing, the application shall be granted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That Certificate of Authority No. 186 is hereby terminated, effective this date.

2. That within 30 days from the date of this order applicant shall:

- a. remove from applicant's vehicle(s) the identification placed thereon pursuant to Commission Regulation No. 61;
- b. file a notarized affidavit and supporting photograph(s) with the Commission verifying compliance with the preceding requirement; and
- c. surrender Certificate No. 186 to the Commission.
